### Self-learning Arrangement and Other Important Notes

In view of the latest development of the epidemic, the Education Bureau announced all classes will be resumed as early as 2<sup>nd</sup> March. To complement the latest preventive measures of HKSAR, all people entering Hong Kong from the mainland will receive a 14-day compulsory quarantine orders. Please pay attention if your child is still under the 14-day compulsory quarantine orders after the school suspension. 2.1 If you have not returned the completed application form of 2019/2020 Student Grant yet, please return it to the class teacher once the school is resumed.
