**Special Arrangement on Primary 6 Second Examination and Self-Learning at Home**

In the view of the latest situation of the epidemic, The Education Bureau announced that all schools would further defer class resumption until 16 March the earliest. We have set up the cleansing of our premises and put in place all the preventive measures. Students should strictly comply with the preventive measures suggested by the local authorities no matter they are in Hong Kong or in the Mainland, in order to prepare themselves for resumption of school.

**1 Special Arrangement on Primary 6 Second Examination**

- 1.1 Due to the deferral of class resumption, the Primary 6 Second Examination is being cancelled. Students’ internal assessment results at the end of Primary 5 and the results of the first examination in Primary 6 will be used for the calculation of allocation bands for the Secondary School Places Allocation (SSPA).
- 1.2 Since the second examination for Primary 6 students is cancelled, a school-based internal assessment will be conducted in order to evaluate the learning progress of the students. Details will be announced later. Students should keep on learning in order to better equip themselves for secondary curriculum.


2.2 Parents can download the relevant materials and assist the students to complete the challenges and become the challenge master.

- 3.2 The Sports Day on 18<sup>th</sup> March is cancelled. Students will have normal time-tabled lessons on 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> March if school resumes on 16<sup>th</sup> March.
- 3.3 72<sup>nd</sup> Hong Kong Schools Music Festival(2020): Classes and events involving live performances are cancelled.
