To all P.6 Parents,

Application for SSPA 2018/2020 Cross-Net Allocation(Final Batch)

The final batch of applications for cross-net allocation for the SSPA 2018/2020 is now invited. If a P.6 student would like to change his/her school net, his/her parent may apply for cross-net allocation.

A. Who can apply

1. Any Primary 6 students who do NOT live in “KL1”- Yau Tsim Mong
2. The applicant should be the parent/guardian of the student in the record kept by school and live with the student in the same residential address.
3. The applying student’s residential address should be his/her sole or chief residential address.

B. How to apply

1. To facilitate the planning of the provision of Secondary 1 school places in each school net for central allocation, applicants should complete the application form and submit it with the original copy of the documentary proofs of the residential address.
2. The name and address of the parent/guardian (i.e. the payee) must be printed on the residential address proof document.
3. Acceptable residential address proof documents include stamped tenancy agreement, demand note for rates/government rent, tenancy agreement or rent card issued by the public housing authorities, residential telephone bill, and the bills from various utility companies, like Towngas, HK Electricity Company Ltd, Water Supplies Department etc. Other documents such as bank statements and mobile phone bills will not be accepted.
4. Parent who wants to apply should bring along the mentioned address proof document to school on 4 March (Wednesday) or 5 March (Thursday) during office hour (9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.). Our staff will help to collect your document and give you an application form to fill in.
All visitors should wear masks in our school premises and we will take the temperature. If you have been to China, you can only enter our school after 14 day home isolation.

C. When to apply

Parents should complete and submit the application form with the residential proof on or before 5 March (Thursday). If students have moved to other district after the application deadline, they will have to apply direct to the secondary schools in the district concerned after the release of the allocation results on 7 July 2020.

D. Points to note

1. Successful applicants will be notified before the central allocation process starts. Students will be given the secondary school information according to their residential area instead of YauTsimMong.
2. Parents can choose to stay in KL1 net by NOT applying Cross Net Allocation.
