
2.2 Parents should assist and encourage students to attend the live lessons punctually.

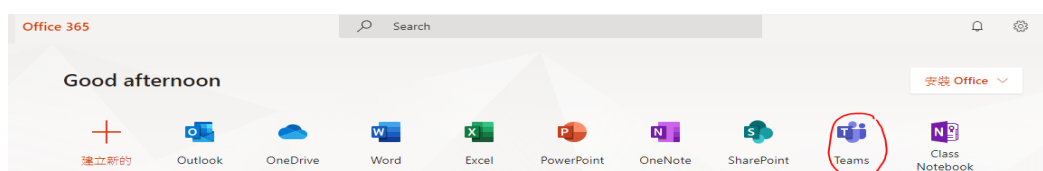
