3. 2019/20 “Mathematics Olympiad Course” and “Cambridge English Course” Arrangement



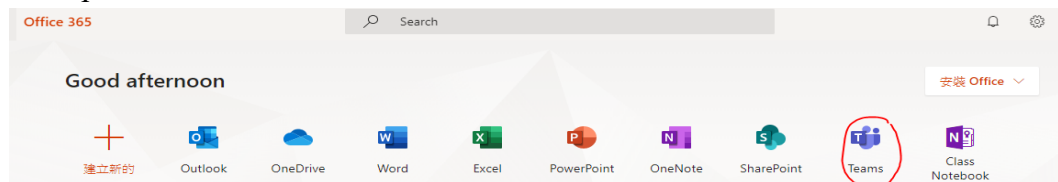
