**'Growth and Promise' School Development and Relocation Project 2020-2026**

We would like to take this opportunity to express our gratitude for your continued support for our school. With our motto being '仁愛誠信 博學利群' or 'to serve the community through extensive learning with benevolence and integrity', our school has endeavored to provide quality education for our students. Focusing on the academic and personal growth of our students while encouraging active engagement in community service, our school has sought improvement unceasingly and has enjoyed steady development. In recent years, our school's promotion of 'life education' and 'inquiry-based learning' through the 'Distinctive Curriculum' (特色課) has gained recognition and compliments by parents and the Education Bureau.

There will be rapid progress of development for our school in the coming 6 years. Through improving the school environment, education curriculum and services of higher quality will be provided in 3 phases. In Phase I (2020-22), our school has obtained the approval from the government for enhancement works for classrooms and additional air-conditioning system for our G/F school hall. There will also be complete renovation for our library, visual arts room and music room. The improvement of the environment will further enhance the quality of teaching as well as promote reading culture, arts education and the ongoing optimisation of our school's music curriculum.

For Phase II (2022-25), our school has successfully applied for the CoolThnk@JC Project by Hong Kong Jockey Club, which aims to promote systematic teaching of computational thinking and coding across primary school classrooms. By utilising social resources and government funding, our school plans to optimise the facilities of our computer room to develop school-based creative STEM curriculum so as to better equip our students to face the challenges of technology developments of the 21<sup>st</sup> century.

Phase III of the Project will take place in the school year 2025-26. To solve the problem posed by inadequate space in the long run and to continue with our school's excellent teaching tradition, our school plans to relocate to new school premises on Anderson Road, Sai Kung where supporting facilities are more comprehensive. The relocation will enhance learning and strengthen the long-term development of the school.

Our school will enjoy continuous development in the near future and will provide students with better education. Meanwhile, we will also ensure that educational needs of our students are properly taken care of. It is foreseen that P1-P5 students of our school will benefit from the said school development project by effectively studying in a consistently-improving school environment. Our school will also provide support to parents of new P1 students allocated to our school and assist them to finish P6 in this district.
