**Summer Reading Activities**


1. Summer Reading Programme - “Gift Book Pilot Scheme (2020)”

“Gift Book Pilot Scheme (2020)” launched by Education Bureau offers a free printed book to each primary or secondary student in the public sector schools and direct subsidy scheme schools, with the goals to encourage leisure reading anytime and anywhere during summer holiday, and nurture students’ good reading habits. The scheme has the full support from the Hong Kong Publishing Federation.

Taken students’ ability, students’ interest and the supply of books in to consideration, the school has chosen some suitable books from EDB’s “Designated Book Lists”, and each student may receive different book in this case. However due to the large amount of publication, the books are not yet available to be given out before summer holiday and will be given out during summer holiday. Parents will be invited to choose a book at school during summer holiday, while it is on first-come first-served basis.

2. “eRead Scheme”

To encourage students’ extensive reading, the school has joined the free use of “eRead Scheme” offered by HKedCity for the period from 16 July to 31 December. This scheme offers primary and secondary students free access to English and Chinese quality ebooks that cover different topics and levels. Students may read at most 100 books during the above period.
